# *Iowa Horse Fair Cowgirl Queen Contest Entry Rules*

## Order of events:

Check In: All contestants must be checked in at the horse barn office and stalled by noon on Saturday. Contestants may arrive Friday.

Participation- If you would like to volunteer to help around the fair Friday and Saturday you are more than welcome but not required. Contact Crystal.

## Contest:

### Saturday

Introductions before the rodeo performance. Please meet at the horse barn office at 6:30 pm. You must have a rodeo ticket if you wish to attend the rodeo.

### Sunday

Pattern handed out at 9 am at the horse barn office.

Warm-up – will be in the outdoor area by pavilion unless inclement weather, then will be inside pavilion. 15 min before contest.

Pattern/ Queen Salute contest to start at 2 pm!

Individual question is the tie breaker if needed

Further details will be discussed at check in.

Judging: Is scored as follows: 75 points pattern and 25 for salute.

Crowning: There will be 1 queen per division with 3 attendants. If the newly crowned queen for some reason cannot fulfill her duties the first attendant will be asked to step up to fill the queen's role. The Iowa horse council has the final judgement if this will be necessary.

The newly crowned queen will need to be accompanied by parent for signing of contracts after pictures have been taken. Contract signing will take place in the horse barn office.

Both Queens will be able to represent the Iowa Horse Fair at the Iowa State Fair Cowgirl Queen contest.

## Requirements:

Contestants must be ages 10-15 by January 1 to compete in Junior division, and must be ages 16-26 by January 1 to compete in Senior Division. **NOTE: You do not have to have a title to compete!!!!!! This contest is Open.**

The first 20 applications will be taken in each division. You will be notified if you made the 20 contestant cut. Payment is due with application. New this year is paying online!!! All competitors will be set in stone on March 1. Applications received after the 20 cut or past the

deadline will be returned and contact verified. If payment made online is refunded it will be minus the processing fee.

**Contestants must live in Iowa.**

All contestants are to be in western show attire, show blouse or vest, pants, chaps, Cowboy hat, helmet with appropriate tack for riding portion. No training equipment. Helmets are not required but are strongly encouraged!! There will be no penalty for wearing a helmet.

Nice western clothing required for introductions before the rodeo Saturday evening.

Stalling Procedures:

All Cowgirl Queen Contestants will be stalled. Showing out of trailer will not be permitted. Stall assignments will be available at the Horse Barn Office at check-in. You will receive your Queen packet at that time. Iowa Horse fair board decisions on stalling assignments are final.

All contestants must have health certificate for horse within 30 days.

All out-of-state horses must have negative coggins test within 1 year and health certificate within 30 days. NO Stallions please!

All contestants must vacate stalls after the contest. Stall Decorations are encouraged, stall decorating contest flyer is available!
